

Loft Insulation



Without insulation as much as 15% of a property's heat can be lost through the roof. Insulation will keep homes warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer as well as providing sound insulation which is a particular benefit if you live in a noisy area.

Many properties already have some loft insulation, but any property with a depth less than 270mm normally needs topping up. **Loft Insulation** quilts should be laid horizontally between the joists. This will typically make the insulation about 100 to 150mm (4-6 inches) deep. More layers are then added at right angles, to close any gaps between the joists.

As part of the process the loft hatch is draught proofed and water tanks and pipes are fully insulated.

The whole installation process typically takes about two hours per property.
